

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-64

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION TO ADVERTISE ACCORDING TO LAW AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR PAVEMENT REPAIRS ON CERTAIN CITY STREETS AND ALLOWING FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Wooster requires repairs to be made and resurfacing performed on Palmer Street (north of Bowman), Oak Hill Road (south of Wayne), and concrete pavement replacements on the portion of W. Liberty Street between W. Bowman and Oak Hill Road; and

WHEREAS, this project will be included in the appropriations budget for 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Director of Administration is authorized to advertise according to law and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the repairs and resurfacing of Palmer Street (north of Bowman), Oak Hill Road (south of Wayne), and concrete pavement replacements on the portion of W. Liberty Street between W. Bowman and Oak Hill Road.

SECTION 2. The cost of such contract will not exceed the amount that will be budgeted.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution occurred in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department or division; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of Council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
