

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
ACCEPT AND APPLY GRANT MONIES FROM THE
EDWARD BYNE JAG GRANT AND ALLOWING FOR
IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

WHEREAS, the Police Division received a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice to pay seventy-five percent (75%) of the cost of purchasing an Oculus camera system for officers; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to purchase protective equipment for officers for officer safety purposes.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to formally accept the funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept grant monies in the amount of \$10,908.00, awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice, in accordance with the terms of the Edward Byne Jag Grant.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution occurred in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department or division, and for the further reason that prompt acceptance is necessary in order to utilize the grant monies for the continued training, health and safety of the police division personnel; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of the Council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
