

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-50

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO EXPEND ADDITIONAL FUNDS WITH HERITAGE POOL SUPPLY GROUP/OP AQUATICS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO THE MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER'S SWIMMING FACILITIES, AND ALLOWING FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the supplies and maintenance of the City of Wooster's outdoor swimming pools and spray ground, and Heritage Pool Supply Group/OP Aquatics is familiar with the needs of the Recreation Division; and

WHEREAS, Heritage Pool Supply Group/OP Aquatics possesses the professional expertise to provide the maintenance services necessary for the city's swimming facilities; and

WHEREAS, the cost of Heritage Pool Supply Group/OP Aquatics services is likely to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) within several months; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this expenditure is included in the 2024 Appropriations Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Director of Finance is authorized to expend additional funds to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), but not to exceed seventy-five thousand (\$75,000.00), for maintenance services with Heritage Pool Supply Group/OP Aquatics.


SECTION 2. The cost of such additional expenditures will not exceed the amount budgeted.




