

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-51

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO EXPEND ADDITIONAL FUNDS WITH MD SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS RELATED TO THE MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND ALLOWING FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide the supplies and materials to maintain the City of Wooster's traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, MD Solutions, Inc. has the best pricing available through bids already performed by the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the cost of supplies and materials from MD Solutions, Inc. is likely to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) within several months; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this expenditure is included in the 2024 Appropriations Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Director of Finance is authorized to expend additional funds to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) for supplies and materials from MD Solutions, Inc.

SECTION 2. This contract is exempt from the requirements of competitive bidding pursuant to section 160.03 of the Wooster Codified Ordinances because the purchase can be accomplished upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications, but at a price which is equal to or lower than that which is available from a State-sponsored cooperative purchasing program.

SECTION 3. The cost of such additional expenditures will not exceed the amount budgeted.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution occurred in an open meeting of this Council, in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This resolution is declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the City; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of the Council, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
