

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-55

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A MINI EXCAVATOR AND ALLOWING FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

WHEREAS, this City Council adopted an annual budget for 2024, and such budget includes the purchase of a mini excavator; and

WHEREAS, the mini excavator will allow the City's Utilities Division to work more efficiently and safely.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Director of Administration is authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a mini excavator.

SECTION 2. This contract is exempt from the requirements of competitive bidding pursuant to section 160.03 of the Wooster Codified Ordinances because the purchase can be accomplished upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications, but at a price which is equal to or lower than that which is available from a State-sponsored cooperative purchasing program.

SECTION 3. The cost of such contract will not exceed the amount budgeted.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution occurred in an open meeting of this Council or its committees in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department or division; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of Council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
