ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR FULL-TIME PUBLIC SAFETY DISPATCHERS

The public safety dispatcher's primary responsibility is to provide emergency and non-emergency communications response to individuals and entities requesting police, fire, or emergency medical services. Candidates must be able to deal with citizens in a heightened emotional state and provide clear instructions to keep citizens safe and responders informed with critical information prior to their arrival. The dispatch center will be a 24/7 operation. Starting hourly wage will be \$20.49/hour. Candidates with prior experience will receive a higher starting hourly rate.

Qualifications: Qualified candidates must have a high school diploma or equivalent. Excellent communication skills and the ability to multi-task are vital qualities for successful candidates. Prior service in a public safety dispatch environment is preferred, but not mandatory. Candidates must be able to successfully pass an extensive background investigation. A valid Ohio issued driver's license is preferred. Must be eligible and able to obtain and maintain State of Ohio LEADS certification within 1 year of hire. Must obtain International Academies of Emergency Dispatch Police, Fire, and Medical certifications within 1 year of hire.
