

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION
ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Wooster adopted an Annual Appropriation Ordinance No. 2023-28 for Fiscal Year 2024, and from time to time it becomes necessary to amend that Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a Target of Opportunity Program grant in the amount of \$192,500 for the calendar year July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2026, from the Ohio Department of Development for the purpose of assisting the Viola Startzman Clinic in expanding mental health services; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that for calendar year 2024, grant fund expenditures will not exceed \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the balance of unspent grant funds in 2024 will be included in the 2025 annual appropriations ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the amount of \$50,000 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated balance in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Fund (107) for the purposes set forth above.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance occurred in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, in compliance with law.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of Council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
