

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-61

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AND ALLOWING FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wooster is planning to make capital improvements, more particularly, replacing waterlines on Gasche Street and S. Columbus Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority needed for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Director of Administration is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

SECTION 2: The Director of Administration is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department or division; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of the Council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
