

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION  
ORDINANCE, AND ALLOWING FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Wooster adopted an Annual Appropriation Ordinance No. 2023-28 for Fiscal Year 2024, and from time-to-time it becomes necessary to amend that Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. Wooster City Council authorized the filing of an application with the Ohio Department of Transportation for transportation grants.

SECTION 2. The City was awarded a grant to fund a transportation manager for a period of one year.

SECTION 3. The grant is a reimbursement type grant, meaning the City must first make expenditures then seek reimbursements. In order to do so, the City needs to transfer funds to the Transportation Grant Fund (131).

SECTION 4. That the amount of \$50,000 is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated General Fund (100) balance to the Interfund Cost Center, with a related transfer to the Transportation Grant Fund (131), where it is hereby appropriated.

SECTION 5. This Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance occurred in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, in compliance with law.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of Council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
