

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-79

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION TO PURCHASE FLOCK CAMERAS, INCLUDING INSTALLATION AND YEARLY SUBSCRIPTION, FOR USE BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ALLOWING FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

WHEREAS, the City requires the purchase of license plate reading cameras for crime deterrence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Director of Administration is authorized to purchase seventeen Flock cameras, including installation and yearly subscription.

SECTION 2. Bidding is not necessary for this purchase pursuant to W.C.O. 160.03(d)(2).

SECTION 3. The cost of such purchase will not exceed the amount budgeted.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution occurred in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department or division; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of Council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
