## RESOLUTION NO. 2024-99

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE RESURFACING OF VARIOUS STREETS AND ALLOWING FOR IMMEDIATE ENACTMENT

WHEREAS, Section 5501.03 (C) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) may coordinate the activities of the Department with other appropriate public authorities and enter into contracts with such authorities as necessary to carry out its duties, powers and functions; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio Department of Transportation has committed to funding 80% of the construction costs for this project in FY 2026 with remaining costs to be budgeted in FY 2026; and

WHEREAS, the LPA (Local Public Agency), the City of Wooster, has received funding approval for the project listed above from the Program Manager having responsibility for the federal/state funds involved: and

WHEREAS, it is the mutual desire of both ODOT and the LPA to have the LPA serve as the responsible lead agency for the administration of the project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to resurface Burbank Road (Quinby Avenue to Elm Drive), E. Wayne Avenue (Beall Avenue to Palmer Street), E. Larwill Street (N. Market Street to Beall Avenue), W. Liberty Street (Oak Hill Road to Larwill Street), and Prairie Lane Road (Old Columbus Road to the RR tracks).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOSTER, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Director of Administration is authorized to enter into an agreement with ODOT to facilitate the resurfacing of Burbank Road (Quinby Avenue to Elm Drive), E. Wayne Avenue (Beall Avenue to Palmer Street), E. Larwill Street (N. Market Street to Beall Avenue), W. Liberty Street (Oak Hill Road to Larwill Street), and Prairie Lane Road (Old Columbus Road to the RR tracks).

SECTION 2. This Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution occurred in an open meeting of this Council or its committees in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City, or providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department or division, and for the further reason that an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation ODOT is necessary to begin the plan approval process; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and

immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of Council; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
