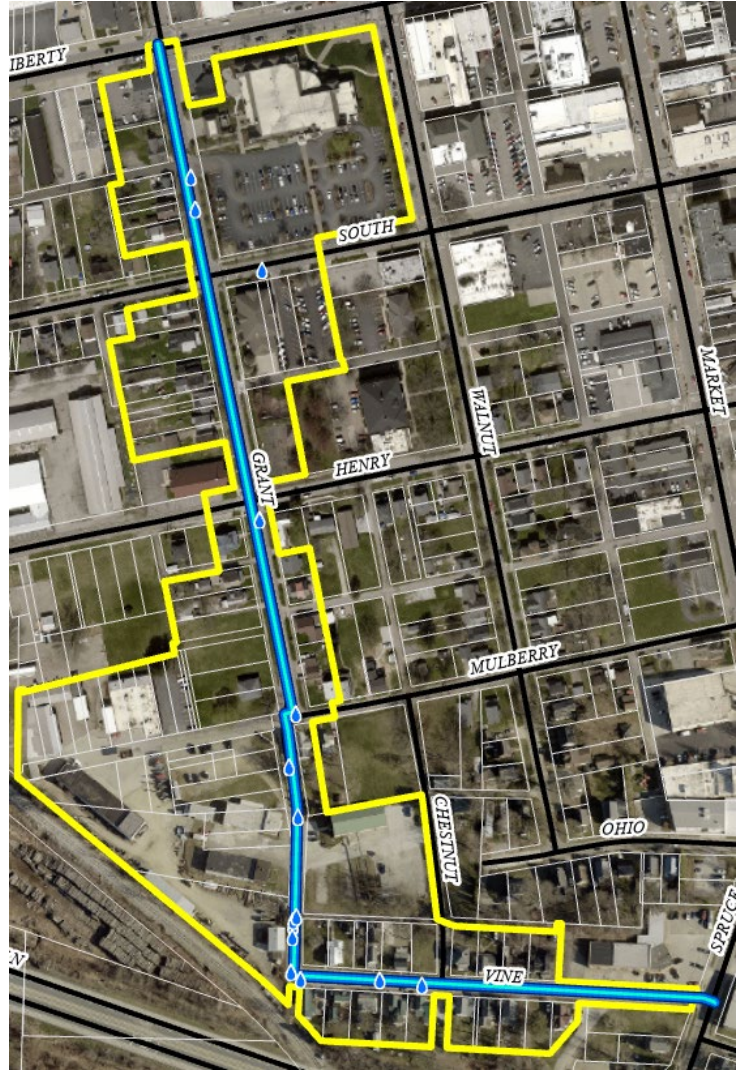


Grant & Vine Street Waterline Replacement Project with Proposed CDBG Grant

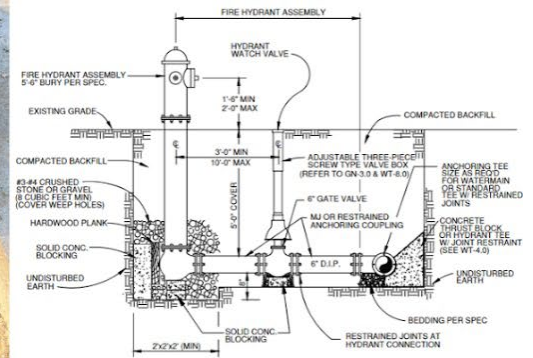
The City of Wooster is working to replace a series of waterlines serving homes on Grant and Vine streets with a new 16-inch diameter ductile-iron waterline which will provide reliable water service for the next 50 to 100 years, and also enhance fire safety. The current lines range between 4-inches and 16-inches in diameter depending on location, with some sections approaching 100 years in age. The City has repaired 14 breaks along this route in recent years, which are expected to become more common with age. A new waterline would reduce the occurrence of breaks, ensure proper pressure and flow, and support water quality for future generations.

The City of Wooster is currently exploring a federal CDBG Critical Infrastructure Grant to help cover a portion of the project's estimated cost in hopes of moving forward with the work in 2027.

- NOTES:
1. CENTER OF THE FIRE HYDRANT SHALL BE LOCATED BETWEEN 2'-0" AND 10'-0" FROM THE BACK OF THE CURB.
 2. A 3 FOOT CLEAR SPACE SHALL BE MAINTAINED AROUND THE CIRCUMFERENCE OF THE FIRE HYDRANT.
